### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- General sanitation of winery equipment and barrels
- Assist in receiving, weighing, sorting and processing fruit
- Pump operation
- Performing punch downs and pump-overs
- Transfer of wine and juice from tank to tank
- Removing pomace from tanks and press
- Barrel filling and topping
- Ability to lift 50 lbs.
- Other cellar work as assigned
- Forklift experience preferred but not required
- Previous winery experience preferred but not required

### **Time Frame/Working Hours:**

- This position begins approximately Early-Mid September, 2010 and finishes in November, 2010.
- Work will usually begin around 7 AM; though harvest conditions dictate flexibility, and can include partial shifts and weekends. Work will generally end around 10 or 11 PM.
